## Yarn Weight System

|  |  <br> Category | Types of Yarns | Suggested Hook Size |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
|  | Lace | Fingering, Size 10 Thread | $1.6-1.4$ mm |
|  | Super Fine | Sock, Fingering, Baby | $2.25-3.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ |
|  | Fine | Sport, Baby | $3.5-4.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ |
|  | Light | DK, Light Worsted | $4.5-5.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ |
|  | Medium | Worsted, Afghan, Aran | $5.5-6.5$ mm |
|  | Bulky | Chunky, Craft, Rug | 6.5-9 mm |
|  | Super Bulky | Bulky, Roving | 9 mm \& larger |
